Barbados requires individuals travelling on passports or travel documents issued from some countries to obtain an entry visa prior to travel.

Immigration and Customs Form

All arriving visitors must supply Barbados immigration with the full address of where they will be staying to be allowed entry into the island.

All arriving visitors are required to submit a correctly completed immigration/customs form. Customs forms can be filled out online (available [here](#) 72h prior to your arrival in Barbados) or directly at the airport upon arrival.

The Venue

The 2025 SEforALL Global Forum will take place on 12 -13 March 2025 at the Lloyd Erskine Sandiford Center (LESC), Two Mile Hill St. Michael BB11093 Barbados. The Organising Team will arrange a shuttle bus service between the venue and the main hotels of the area.

Arriving by plane

[Grantley Adams International Airport](#) (GAIA) (IATA: BGI, ICAO: TBPB) is the international airport of Barbados. It is about 13 kilometers from the center of the capital city Bridgetown, in an area officially known as Seawell.

The Grantley Adams International Airport is located approximately 20 minutes (14km) from the Forum venue, the Lloyd Erskine Sandiford Center ([LESC](#)).

Connection between airport and Bridgetown

There are two main options to get from the Airport to Bridgetown: taxi or bus. Taking an airport taxi or private transfer is the quickest transfer option, with a journey time of 25 minutes; a local cab will charge you around \$37 (BBD 74) to cover this route. You can get a taxi from the airport terminal grounds.

The Line 27 [bus](#), on the other hand, takes closer to 40 minutes to reach Bridgetown and costs \$2 (BBD 4) per traveler.

Hotel Shuttles and Private Transfer at Grantley Adams International Airport

Many hotels have shuttle services though some might require prior reservations. Please confirm if this service is available at your accommodation.

Passenger pick-up and drop off passengers in front of the terminal grounds of the airport.

Fares may vary for this service. Please call the hotel front desk for further information.

Generally, transfers are usually available 24 hours and are only ideal if you have the budget and you want comfort after your flight to Barbados.

Prices are around US \$50.00 per person.

Power Sockets

For Barbados, there are two associated plug types, types A and B. Plug type A is the plug which has two flat parallel pins and plug type B is the plug which has two flat parallel pins and a grounding pin.

Barbados operates on a 115V supply voltage and 50Hz. You may need a power plug travel adapter for sockets type A and B.

Security

Security and access will be enforced at the 2025 SEforALL Global Forum. Registration badges must be displayed at all times. Registration and badges are not transferrable and under no circumstances should your badge be lent to another participant.

Currency Exchange

The Barbados dollar is the national currency of the island of Barbados. The currency is abbreviated as BBD in the foreign exchange market and is often represented by the symbol Bds\$.

Credit and debit cards are widely accepted. Some businesses, including the majority of supermarkets, require you to show a valid photo ID when you use your credit or debit card, and some might request your passport.
